BLOCKS

An Community Center like a park inside a park

The disposition of the interior blocks are a most value for the functional organization, but also individualize them.

The blocks are treated individually, but they make a whole together, communicating with each other by their position.

Direct and rapid access to each room is possible, and also more flexible, concerning the great amount and variety of people that access it

CORRIDORS

Make your own circulation path

Since the center is very wide, accessibility as to be as natural like a "walk in the park", so multiple entrances are provided to guarantee more flexibility.

The circulation pattern interrelates zones, rather than forming a strongly hierarchical circulation pattern.

The strong relation to the paths that involve the building, is a big help for orientation inside/outside.

The corridors are usable as exposition areas, showing works made by the people of the work-shops, creating pedagogical and culture paths.

- Unique size of passage width of the doors, 1meter. Easy access to the spectators stand with ramps, in the multi purpose hall. First floor access ramp with an inclination of 6%
- Each block has a characteristic material, that evoke sensations for the person, so than they can "build" a image of each block. Wide (3meter min.) corridors with guide lines and orientation marks, make a easy experience walking in the center.
- Children block is displaced in the first floor, so that they can be more easily watched by their responsible, even if he/she is taking a coffee break after arriving of work, eating or reading. Communication with other functional blocks, works also as an pedagogical contact.
